Harvest Festival will be a village service on **27 Sept at St Andrews 10.15 am**. Our church will have a harvest display on one of the windows. We will have a collection of dry goods as usual - last year these went to the food bank, (but it depends what the school are doing this year) A box is under the table by the front door for your contributions.

An Alpha course will be run at our Church together with people from St Andrew's for 10 weeks starting Monday 5 October. Alpha is a series of interactive sessions with a light supper, talk and group discussions, that freely explore the basics of the Christian faith. No pressure. No follow up. No charge.
